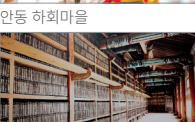
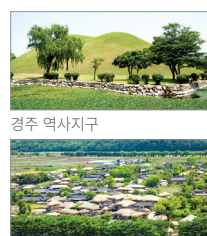
The Hub of the National Medical Industry, Korea's Medi-city

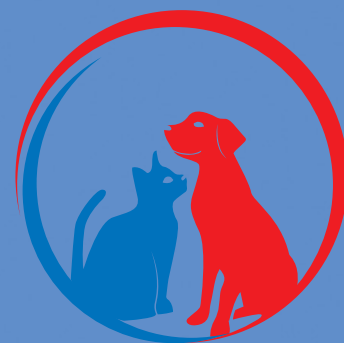

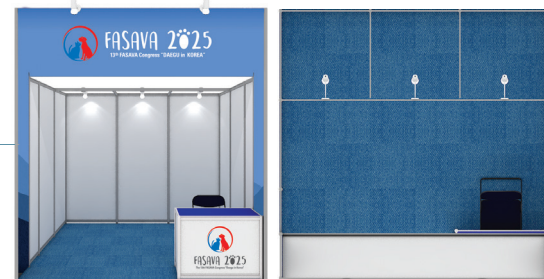

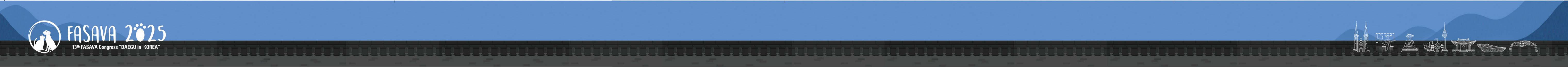
